

**Minutes of the Extraordinary Meeting of Brompton Town Council held in the Methodist Church,  
Brompton on Tuesday 12th July 2022**

PRESENT – Councillors Mrs S Brigginsshaw, Mr R Carter, Mr J Hazelwood, Mr M Langthorne, Mrs M Shiel Dods (in the Chair), Mr S O’Sullivan and Mrs A Robinson.

There were 17 members of the public present at the meeting. .

1. APOLOGIES AND DECLARATIONS OF INTERESTS.

Apologies for absence were received from Councillors Kelly and Smith and from District Councillors Mrs Sanderson.

2. TO CONSIDER PLANNING APPLICATION 22/00739/FUL - For change of use of land for an additional 6no Gypsy/Traveller pitches comprising 6 no. static caravans, 6no day rooms, 6no touring caravans, and associated works

LOCATION: Land To The Rear Of The Workshop Stokesley Road

The Chairman reported that all Councillors had been supplied before the meeting with copies of the cases put forward by Ruston Planning on behalf of the applicant and ELG Planning acting on behalf of a number of residents together with the District Councils Gypsy and Traveller Policy.

The public present at the meeting expressed concerns with regard to the additional traffic movements that the development would cause on Stokesley Road and whether what screening that was on site currently would still remain there in the future. Other issues mentioned were contamination, the effect on the amenity value of other properties and the dangers to people walking along Lead Lane which had no footpath and was unlit.

After listening to the comments made by those present it was AGREED - That the Planning Authority be informed that Brompton Town Council has no objections to the planning application subject to the Highway Authority being satisfied as to arrangements for entrance and exit to the site to and from Stokesley Road.
